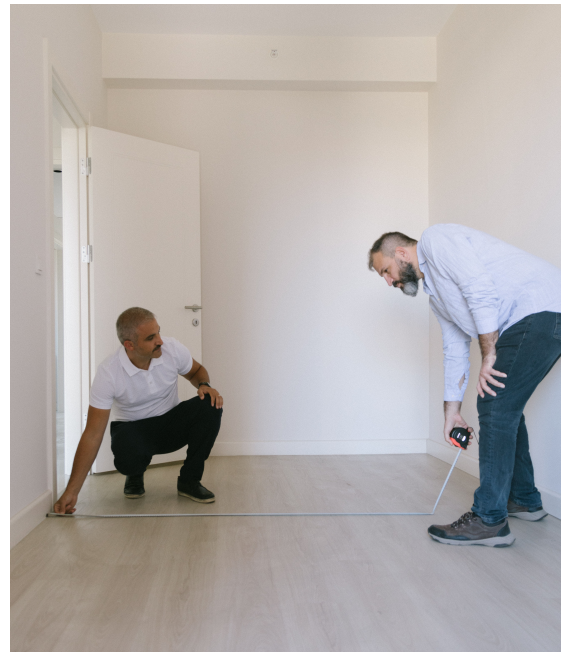
Measure the Space

Measuring the space is one of the most important steps before selecting new furniture.



Measure the width of the space you are furnishing.

Measure the depth from the wall to the nearest obstacle, coffee table, etc. Tip: A coffee table is typically 18" away from the edge of a seat. **Depth**_____



When measuring for a sectional or sofa with chaise, it is important to measure each depth from left, middle, and right while facing the wall. Tip: This will determine if you need a right facing, left facing, or u-shaped sectional.

Measure the height of the space from the floor to the nearest obstacle like a window.

Walk the Path

Walking the path is important to do before selecting new furniture.



Measure any exterior doorways. **Tip: You can remove the doors from the hinges, if necessary.**

Measure any interior doorways. Sometimes, interior doors are narrower than exterior doors.

Measure the stairway. Be sure to measure the width in multiple places especially if there is a turn.
